DIG DEEPER QUESTIONS

- 1. What would people say that 'you are always doing'? Can you think of someone of whom you would say, 'they're always serving others'? What is their serving motivated by? Could that be said of you?
- 2. Read John 13:1-17. What stands out to you in this account? What was the response of the disciples? Why did Peter respond the way that he did? Jesus says that His followers should "wash one another's feet" (13:14). What does this mean practically? How good are you at "washing others' feet"?
- 3. Aaron talked about how Jesus humbled himself and served us. Name some examples of how Jesus served in the Gospels and how he serves us now.
- 4. 'Serving isn't something that you do. A servant is who you are.' What does this look like practically? How does this differentiation impact the way you serve or see different opportunities?
- 5. During the sermon, there was a call for every one of us to be serving somewhere. Where do you currently use your gifts to serve? Where may you feel a nudge to serve? Encourage each other in this and hold each other accountable.
