1. What would people say that *'you are always doing'*? Can you think of someone of whom you would say, 'they're always serving others'? What is their serving motivated by? Could that be said of you?
2. Read **John 13:1-17**. What stands out to you in this account? What was the response of the disciples? Why did Peter respond the way that he did? Jesus says that His followers should "*wash one another's feet*" (13:14). What does this mean practically? How good are you at "*washing others' feet*"?
3. Aaron talked about how Jesus humbled himself and served us. Name some examples of how Jesus served in the Gospels and how he serves us now.
4. '*Serving isn't something that you do. A servant is who you are.*' What does this look like practically? How does this differentiation impact the way you serve or see different opportunities?
5. During the sermon, there was a call for every one of us to be serving somewhere. Where do you currently use your gifts to serve? Where may you feel a nudge to serve? Encourage each other in this and hold each other accountable.
